

## TUESDAY GAMES POINTS

Points are awarded throughout the season for participation, chip-ins and to the winners. At the end of the season, players whose points exceed a minimum threshold will receive cash based on their accumulated points.



Players get points for the following:

One Point for participating in the game.

- SL and MV 18 hole players withdrawing from the game must play at least 9 holes to receive a point and the SL9 players must play at least 7 holes to receive a point.
- If you play at least 7 holes you must post a 9 hole score into GHIN. If you play at least 14 holes you must post an 18 hole score into GHIN.

One point for each chip-in. The chip-in must be noted on the signed scorecard.

Game points are awarded for Winning/Placing within each group (MV18, SL18 or SL9) based on the number of players within the group. The more players in the group, the greater number of points are awarded (see schedule below). On any given game day, roughly 1/4<sup>th</sup> to 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the players will be awarded points for their play provided they meet the following:

- There must be at least 6 players competing in the group to qualify for game points.
  - The Lead Coordinator will use her discretion as to whether a group is eligible for points when a player drops out after play has begun. However, a player injury or emergency that causes a player to quit will not affect the group's eligibility for game points.
  - If a player has a bad day and withdraws during a game but continues playing, your group is still eligible for points.
  - Whether points awarded for rainouts during play will be at the discretion of the Lead Coordinator.
- You are eligible for game points only if you play within your assigned group (i.e. MV18, or SL18 or SL9).
  - The first time you play in a non-scramble format, will determine your assigned group. If you wish, you may notify the Lead Coordinator, as to which group you want to be assigned to.
  - You may play in a different group during the season, but you will receive only participation and chip-in points for that day. You will not be eligible to compete in that group's game. Your points however, will go to your assigned group.
  - If you wish to change groups during the season, your participation points will transfer, but none of the game points or chip in points.
  - Depending on the number of players, 25% or more of the players in each group will receive points for Winning/Placing as shown in the chart below. In case of a tie, both players get the win. For example, if 9 players played and 2 people tied for first place, there would be 2 First Place Winners and no Second Place winner and one Third Place winner.

Players who sign up to play after the 9:00 am Monday deadline for the game day or who do not sign up to play but show up on game day, are welcome to play but will not receive any points for that day.
