Greetings and Happy New Year Mason-Dixon Ladies,

Following are some highlights of The Mason-Dixon Executive Board and Rep meeting that was held in November (many thanks to Lynn and Arlene for attending for me):

\*Playing Schedule (to be confirmed in February): (Notice **two** Fun Days: one in April and the other in September.)

- Tuesday - **April 16, 2019**: Blue Ridge Shadow: Fun Day – Open to Non-Members – Threesome Shamle gross and net – Choose your own team - (that used at Shenandoah for their fall event) – Par 3's all play their own ball (add three scores together and place on scorecard (ex: 9/6); Par 4's pick best drive and everyone plays their own ball in from there (add two lowest scores together and place on scorecard); Par 5's pick the best drive and all hit the second shot from there then pick the best second shot and everyone plays their own ball in from there (add two lowest scores together and place on scorecard).
- Tuesday – **April 30, 2019**: Shenandoah: Two-lady team (best ball gross and net). Choose your own team. **THIS WILL BE A FOURSOME EVENT.**
- Wednesday - May 22, 2019: The Woods: Individual flighted metal play tournament.
- Friday - June 7, 2019: Chambersburg: Individual flighted metal play tournament.
- Wednesday - June 26, 2019: Cress Creek: Individual flighted metal play tournament.
- Thursday - July 18, 2019: Holly Hills: Two-lady team (best ball gross and net). Choose your own team. **THIS WILL BE A FOURSOME EVENT.**
- Tuesday - August 06, 2019: Loudoun: Individual flighted metal play tournament.
- Tuesday - August 20, 2019: Winchester: Individual flighted metal play tournament. Team Trophy will be presented.
- Monday – September 9, 2019: Stoneleigh: Fun Day – Open to Non-Members – Format pick your own Three-lady team – Two Best Ball gross and net.

\* The fee for daily play will remain at \$60.00. Dues is still \$35; \$25 for MDD and \$10 toward our expenses of hosting.

\*We will continue with the 2 score card system: the Daily Prize Score Card and the Official Scorecard.

\*Prospective members must have a home course handicap index that maps to a **30 handicap at their home course when joining**. (This is a change. For us at The Woods, it equates to a handicap index of 28.9 or less.)

\* There is work to establish a free web-page for the posting of rules, handbook, events schedule, etc.
